

ORDINANCE NO. 3300

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT/AGREEMENT WITH SEIBERTKECK INSURANCE PARTNERS FOR THE PROPERTY, INLAND MARINE, EDP, CRIME, BOILER AND MACHINERY, AUTOMOBILE LIABILITY, COMPREHENSIVE MUNICIPAL LIABILITY, LAW ENFORCEMENT LIABILITY, PUBLIC OFFICIALS LIABILITY, AND UMBRELLA EXCESS LIABILITY COVERAGES, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Chardon, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1. The City Manager be and is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract/agreement with SeibertKeck Insurance Partners for the property, inland marine, EDP, crime, boiler and machinery, automobile liability, comprehensive municipal liability, law enforcement liability, public officials liability, and umbrella excess liability coverages in the amount of \$202,129 (Two Hundred Two Thousand, One Hundred Twenty-nine Dollars and No Cents) and in accordance with the specifications on file in the office of the City Manager, being in the best interest of the City of Chardon.

SECTION 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all such deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with the law, including §121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.



This ordinance constitutes an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and welfare, to continue the City's insurance coverage without interruption, and for the further reason that Council wishes to authorize the contract at the earliest possible date, this ordinance shall be effective upon its passage.
