

ORDINANCE NO. 3310

AN ORDINANCE AWARDING THE 2025 SIDEWALK INFILL AND MAINTENANCE PROJECT TO THE LOWEST AND BEST BIDDER AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City solicited bids for the 2025 Sidewalk Infill and Maintenance Project (“Project”);

WHEREAS, the City has reviewed the bids and has determined that Lake County Landscape & Supply is the lowest and best bidder for the Project;

WHEREAS, the Council desires to authorize the Manager to enter into a contract with Lake County Landscape & Supply for the Project.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Chardon, Geauga County, Ohio that:

SECTION 1. That Lake County Landscape & Supply is the lowest and best bidder for the Project, and the Manager is hereby authorized to immediately enter into an agreement with Lake County Landscape & Supply in an amount not to exceed **\$75,795.29** for the Project.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all such deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including §121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance constitutes an emergency measure necessary for the health, safety, and welfare of the City, and for the further reason that Council desires to have the Project completed as quickly as possible to ensure that City sidewalks remain in good maintenance and repair, and, as such shall take effect at the earliest date allowed by law.
