

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT/AGREEMENT WITH GEAUGA HIGHWAY COMPANY FOR 2025 STREET MAINTENANCE AND REPAIR AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Chardon, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1: The City Manager be and is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract/agreement with Geauga Highway Company in the amount of One Hundred Fifty Four Thousand Seven Hundred Dollars (\$154,700.00) for 2025 Street Maintenance and Repair in accordance with the specifications on file in the office of the City Manager, being in the best interest of the City of Chardon.

SECTION 2: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with the law, including §121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


SECTION 3: This ordinance constitutes an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and welfare and for the further reason that Council wishes to authorize the contract to begin road resurfacing and repairs so that the work is completed during the 2025 construction season, this ordinance shall be effective upon its passage.
