

ORDINANCE NO. 3315

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING CERTAIN PUBLIC IMPROVEMENTS DEDICATED BY CIDER MILL TOWNHOMES, LLC FOR PUBLIC USE, AUTHORIZING THE RECORDING OF AN EASEMENT DEDICATION PLAT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Cider Mill Townhomes is a residential development located near the corner of Park Avenue and Tilden Avenue in the City of Chardon; and

WHEREAS, certain public improvements, including the water mains and gravity sanitary sewer mains, have been found to be constructed per the plans submitted to and approved by the City Engineer; and

WHEREAS, the City has conducted a final inspection of said improvements and have found them to be built consistent with the Municipal Specifications; and

WHEREAS, on July 1, 2025, the City Planning Commission recommended approval for the recording the Subdivision and Dedication Plat, through which Cider Mill Townhomes, LLC grants certain rights to various utility companies and through which Cider Mill Townhomes, LLC dedicates the water mains, gravity sanitary sewer mains, and related easements for public use; and

WHEREAS, this Council believes that it is in the best interest of the City of Chardon and the public at large that the City accept the public improvements as noted above.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Chardon, Geauga County, Ohio that:

SECTION 1. The City of Chardon accepts the public improvements set forth on the Subdivision and Dedication Plat that have been dedicated to the public by the Cider Mill Townhomes Development. The Council further finds that those improvements have been built in accordance with the municipal specifications required of said improvements.

SECTION 2. The City Manager, Clerk of Council and City Engineer are authorized to do all acts and to execute all instruments appropriate or necessary to carrying out the terms of accepting the public improvements as provided herein.

SECTION 3. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all such deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including §121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


