

ORDINANCE NO. 3324

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE CHARDON FIRE DEPARTMENT, INC. FOR THE PURCHASE AND REPAYMENT OF A LADDER TRUCK AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Chardon, Geauga County, Ohio that:

SECTION 1. The City Manager is authorized and directed to enter into an agreement with The Chardon Fire Department, Inc. for the purchase and repayment of a ladder truck, under terms and conditions substantially similar to the attached Exhibit A, subject to any changes deemed appropriate by the Manager and Law Director.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all such deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including §121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. This ordinance constitutes an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Chardon; and for the further reason that Council desires to provide the funding necessary to allow the ladder truck to be purchased and put to use as fast as possible.
