

ORDINANCE NO. 3328

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING APPROPRIATIONS IN THE CITY OF CHARDON
TREASURY FOR 2025 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Chardon, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1: The appropriation in the 230 Fire and Ambulance Operating fund be increased in the amount of \$785,000 as follows:

DEPARTMENT	EXPENSE TYPE	AMOUNT
120-FIRE	OPERATING	\$785,000

SECTION 2: The appropriation in the 466 Windemere/Willo Tree RID fund be increased in the amount of \$104.28 as follows:

799- GENERAL ADMINISTRATION	OPERATING	\$104.28

SECTION 3: The appropriation in the 111 General fund be increased in the amount of \$45,000 as follows:

SECTION 4: The appropriation in the 452 General Capital Improvement fund be increased in the amount of \$97,271 as follows:

684- TRAFFIC SIGNS & SIGNALS	CAPITAL	\$97,271

SECTION 5: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all such deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 6: This ordinance constitutes an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and welfare and for the further reason that immediate passage is necessary for the continued daily operation of the City of Chardon, this ordinance shall be effective upon its passage.
