

ORDINANCE NO. 3340

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH DUMPSTER BANDIT, LLC FOR SOLID WASTE COLLECTION AND DISPOSAL SERVICES, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Chardon, Geauga County, Ohio that:

SECTION 1. The City Manager is authorized and directed to enter into an agreement with Dumpster Bandit, LLC, an Ohio Limited Liability Corporation, for solid waste collection and disposal services under terms and conditions substantially similar to those set forth in the City of Chardon's competitive bid solicitation for such services attached as Exhibit A thereto, subject to any changes deemed appropriate by the Manager and Law Director.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all such deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including §121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. This ordinance constitutes an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Chardon; and for the further reason that the current trash hauling contract is set to expire in the near future.
